
The Members Christmas Party is Friday December 7th. We will send you the details as soon as the menu is finalized.

I've always felt more comfortable when I can get into a nice routine here at Valley View. Thinking about the process of aerification tends to make my stomach do funny things. I am so thankful that aerification is not part of our everyday routine...especially when fairway aerification is on the docket. I try to hold off aerifying fairways until late in the golf season. But to hold off too long means bringing Mother Nature into the picture. That means either dealing with MUD or not being able to aerify at all. The jury is still out as to how many fairways we will finish this year. I'm hoping for a few dry weeks to finish them all. One factor that will help is the course being closed November 1st.
