We have reached that dreaded time of year when college classes start, and I am left with about 50% of my maintenance crew. As most of you have noticed, the grass is still growing full tilt...so pull up your bootstraps...it is going to get deep!!! Just kidding...sort of. We will try to stay on top of the mowing situation as best we can. The bunkers might suffer a little, but the goal is to maintain great golfing conditions here at Valley View.

Mother Nature did not help matters when she hit us with the 60 mph winds last Tuesday night. We are still cleaning up tree mess and will be for another week I'm guessing. We performed a modified aerification on the greens a couple weeks ago. I had intended to pull a core but the steady dose of rain we received two days prior caused me to abort the coring mission and instead aerify with a solid crosstine. They turned out incredibly well, and we are for the most part done mowing up sand. Once there is an absence of sand in our greens clippings, we can then put on sharp reels and get back to normal putting conditions.



Once we get through these next couple of weeks dealing with tournaments, we will begin aerifying tees and fairways. Dear Valley View Members,


