Happy October from the restaurant staff!



Course

We are now down the home stretch of our 2023 golf season here at Valley View Golf Club. With that comes a few maintenance events that could possibly impact your round of golf on any given day. All hitting on the driving range will now take place from the mats. Drivers only out on the grass please. For those of you new to this procedure, "mats only" is enforced because there is little to no divot recovery taking place at this time of year. Next spring, we will cover the range tee off area with a woven cover to initiate recovery. For now, EVERYONE please stay on the mats for the remainder of the golf season. Also, we will not be changing cups daily. With very little recovery happening on the greens, the old cup plugs are not healing up so we will minimize the number of times that we are changing pin locations. The only people that will notice this will be those of you who play the golf course every day!!! We have started the process of tee box aerification. As the weather allows, we will continue this process until completion. If you encounter a tee box covered with aerification cores, the tee markers will be located up in front of the tee box. I will return the tee markers once I have the cores cleaned up.

Hopefully we will get an extended fall and have the chance to aerify fairways. If this occurs, we will have a hole shut

down while we aerify and clean up cores. We must allow time for the cores to somewhat dry once the fairway is aerified. This lengthens the amount of time to aerify a fairway. I'm targeting one fairway per day so the members will be playing a 17-hole round of golf. Hopefully Mother Nature allows us to perform this task. We have a few fairways that are in dire need of aerification.

Irrigation system winterization will take place October 24th and 25th. If you will be playing the golf course these days...bring your rain gear!!!

I hope everyone has enjoyed the 2023 golf season. You all know I enjoyed EVERY minute of my time here...haha! Let's have a great October and those of you who I won't see...have a great winter. Stay healthy and we will see you in 2024!

PLEASE replace the monster fairway divots that we continue to find every morning. Show respect for other golfers and your maintenance staff. Thanks.
