The following rules for proper appearance applies to all areas of Valley View Golf Club including the clubhouse, practice area, and course. Those not meeting these standards will be required to comply.

Men's Dress Code:

Shirts: must have collars and sleeves. Golf-specific T-shirts and current golf fashion (as seen on the PGA Tour) are acceptable. Footwear: Shoes are always required.

Women's Dress Code:

Tops: Sleeveless shirts without collars must have shoulder straps at least 2 inches wide. Current golf fashion (as seen on the LPGA Tour) is acceptable. Footwear: Shoes are always required.

Restrictions:

Hiking or Cowboy Boots Cleats From Other Sports Steel Spikes Sweatpants or Gym Shorts Unhemmed Cutoffs Swimwear Tank and Halter Tops, Spaghetti Straps Clothing with Inappropriate Wording

Range | Strip Method:

Please place your ball at the grassy back end of the previous divot removing just a small portion of grass on each swing. This will help the grass grow faster rather than big patches that would take longer to fill.



Pitch Repair:

Right: Using the prongs to push grass at the edge of the depression toward the centre
